Neenah harriers experienced

NEENAH — Three-year letterwinners Kay Monard and Cheryl MacPhetridge lead the Neenah High School girls' cross country team, while returnees with a total of 11 letters between provide the Rockets with a veteran boys' squad.

Monard finished 16th in last year's state meet after placing eighth in the sectional and fifth in the conference run. She was eighth in the conference as a freshman and third in her sophomore year.

Junior Kari Vedder, a 2-year letterwinner, and Jackie Heinen, who lettered as a freshman last fall, are other veterans.

Other members of one of Coach Ron Fedenko's smallest squads include Jill Peterson, Renee Weyenberg, Janet Eifler and Renee Hamilton. Weyenberg lettered on the swimming team last year.

Four-year star Jenny Owens and Lynda Heinen graduated and letterwinner Kate Pichon moved.

Seniors John Hodges, Aaron Pues and John Paske all lettered the last two years on Coach Tom Jensen's boys' squad.

Seniors lettering previously, but not last fall, included Todd Kriese as a freshman and sophomore and Reid Johnson and Steve Scherck as sophomores. Junior Sebastian Sample also lettered last fall.

Jeff Reeve and Pat Eifler were the only lettermen lost by graduation.

Returning non-lettermen on the 25-runner roster also include John Car-

penter, Scott Hauser, Leland Anderson, Geoffrey Sutter, Tim Patterson, Jim Swenson, Mike Price, Dale Clark and Brett Campbell.

Newcomers include Brett Carley, who ran varsity in the opener; junior transfer Kevin Griffith, jayvee winner in the initial race; freshman Tom Syverud, runner-up in the initial jayvee run, and Mike Winters, Jason Syverud, Brad Steffensen, Eric Tremel and Keith Krueger.

The Neenah boys opened with a 21-38 win over Menasha, led by Pues, who finished second, and followed by Paske, Hodges, Johnson, Carley and Carpenter.

Pues was sixth to lead the Rockets to a third-place finish in the Hodag Invitational at Rhinelander Saturday.

The Rocket girls bested the Bluejays 16-47 as Monard, Heinen, MacPhetridge and Peterson took the first four places, and they were third at Rhinelander, paced by Monard's third.

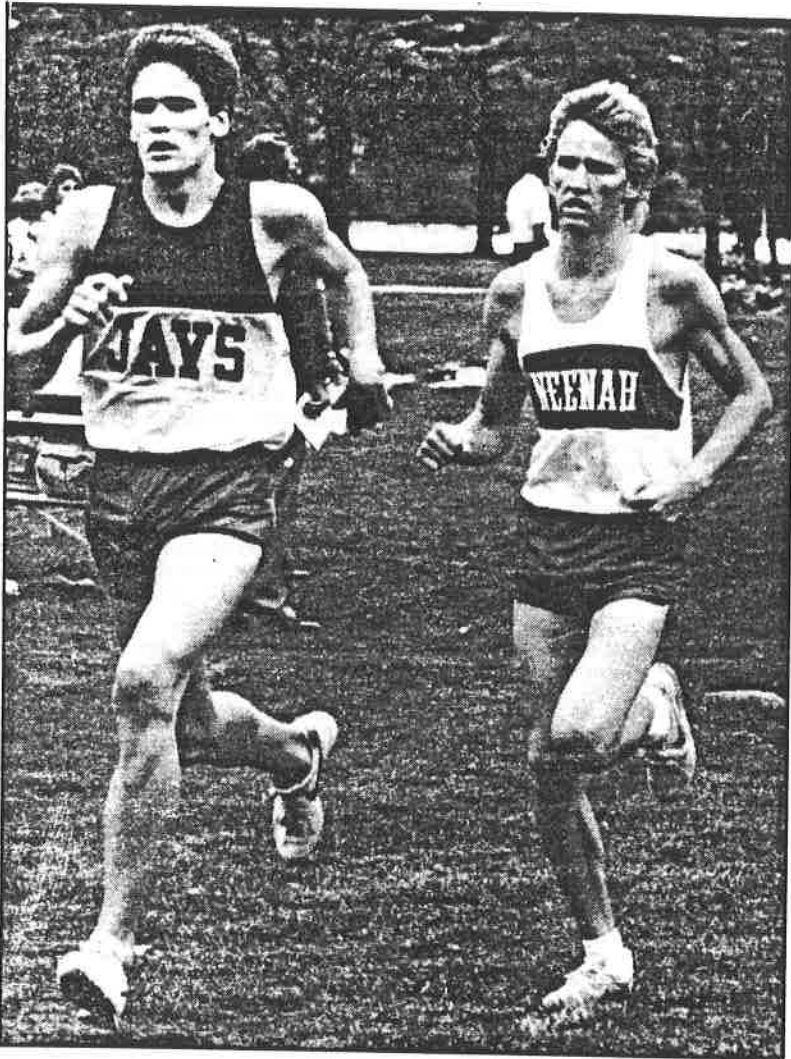
