# Rockets blast from field

Lourdes girls win invitational

The Oshkosh West Quadrangular cross country meet went pretty much as expected Tuesday.

The Neenah boys' and girls' teams dominated in winning their respective races, which had the same order of finish.

The Rockets were followed in both races by Kaukauna in second, Oshkosh North third and Oshkosh West fourth.

Neenah's Tom Syverud won the boys' race as Neenah captured six of the top seven places. Only Kaukauna's Chad Huss, who finished second, prevented a clean sweep by

North's Ben Tremble was the highest Oshkosh finisher, coming in eighth. Jamie Juedes came in 10th for North while Joe Werner was West's top finisher in 18th.

In the girls' race, Neenah's Karen Schaper came in first as the Rockets captured three of the top five places.

West's Christy Schmidt was sixth to lead Oshkosh girls with North's Mahnichone Luangpraseuth coming in eighth and Shelly West finishing ninth.

"We're real young in both boys' and girls'," West coach Russ Hoxtell said. "I was very pleased. I thought we took a big step forward. We had

more time goals than place goals, and we met them."

# Preps: Cross country teams chalk up tournament titles

Achievements recorded by the Neenah and St. Mary Central cross country squads highlighted last week's Twin City prep fall sports schedule.

The Neenah boys' and girls' harriers both swept honors in the Shawano Invitational while the Zephyr boys extended their winning string to three invitationals at Oshkosh Lourdes before finishing second in the St. Lawrence Seminary meet Saturday.

The Rocket boys edged Green Bay Preble 65 to 67 at Shawano while the girls easily handled the field in scoring 46 points to runner-up Manitowoc's 115.

The boys' best individual finish was Tom Syverud's sixth. Rhett Weyenberg was eighth and Tyler Schulz 10th.

For the girls, Karen Schaper came in fifth, Julie Olson eighth, Missy Klabunde ninth, Krista Lawell 11th and Krista Erickson 13th.

It was the Neenah boys' eighth Shawano championship but the first since 1977.

For the girls, the invitational crown was their first since 1986, when they won both the Shawano and Rhinelander titles.

They had won five straight Shawano meet championships between 1980 and 1984.
