# Neenah runners suffer first setback

## ■ Appleton East outscores the Rockets in the Oshkosh North Invitational

Strength at the top produced a victory for the Appleton East cross country team over Neenah in their head-to-head meeting at Thursday's Oshkosh North Invitational.

East, ranked No. 1 in the state at the time, claimed the top three places in scoring 48 points.

Seventh-place Don Alexandroni was the top-finisher for the Rockets, who totaled 62 points.

Ryan Freund was eighth and Jeremy Ondresky finished 12th as the Rockets lost for the first time.

Neenah coach Tom Jensen noted that when the first three runners from each team had crossed the finish line, East had six points to Neenah's 27.

He said Freund hadn't been feeling well but is expected to challenge the Patriot trio in future meets.

Neenah had been ranked second to the Patriots in an earlier state coaches association poll, but when the latest ratings came out Friday, Stevens Point was elevated to first place and East and Neenah dropped to second and third, respectively.

Menasha's Matt Toepler, who garnered fifth place, was the leading finisher among Twin City runners.

He was clocked in 16:54, or 19 seconds behind winner Aaron Sass of the Patriots.

The Bluejays finished in seventh place with 200 points.

Toepler came in 12th when the Bluejays took eighth place among the 15 teams in Saturday's Manitowoc Invitational.

Stevens Point ran away with the meet, scoring 22 points to 120 for

runner-up Green Bay Preble. The Bluejays totaled 234.

St. Mary Central finished third in the 10-team small-school division of the Mishicot Invitational with 108 points.

Menasha, with 115 points, finished fourth in a five-team meet at Kaukauna.

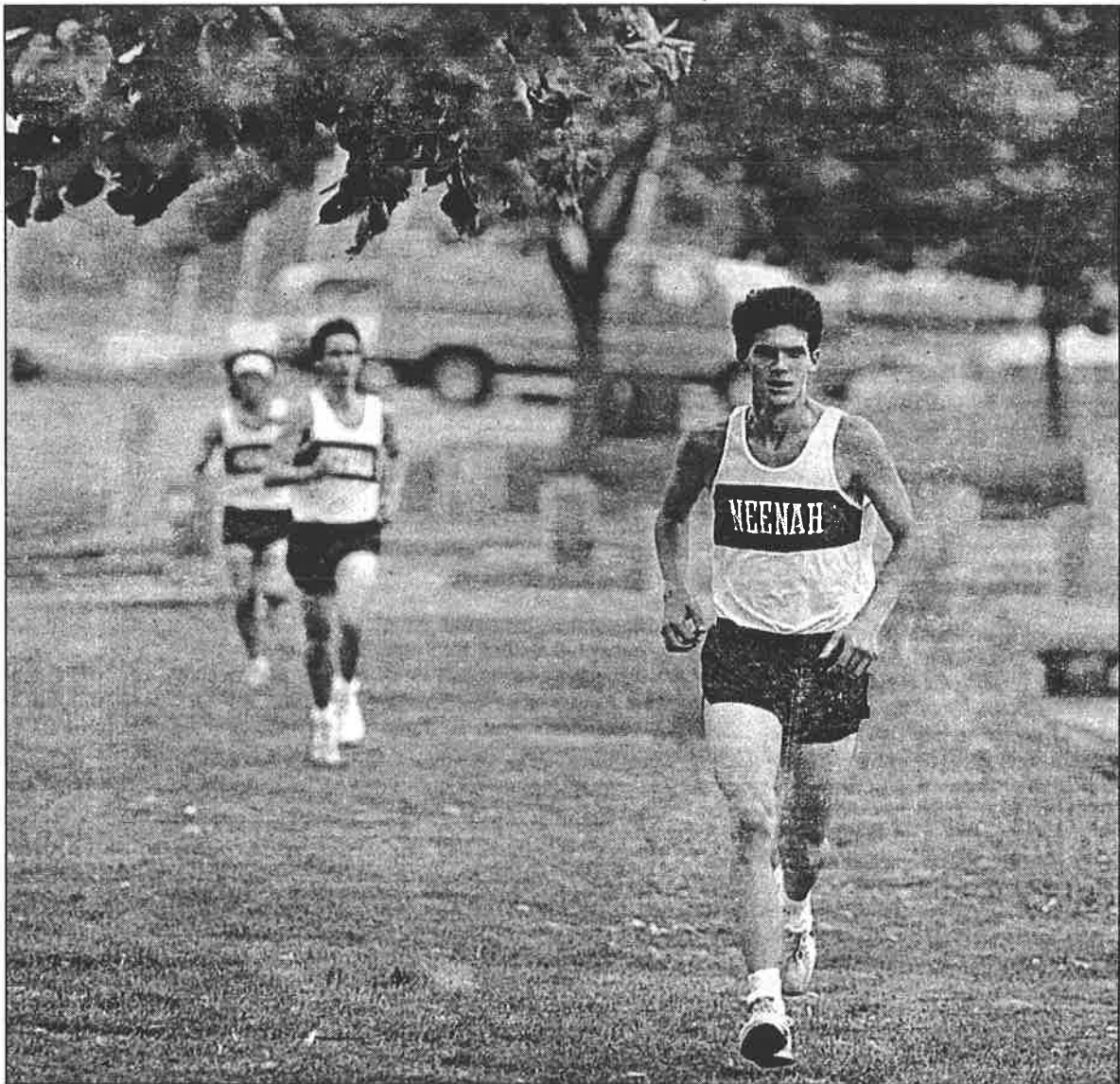
Matt Toepler came home sixth.

### ■ The Neenah harriers claim the first three places at Oshkosh

OSHKOSH — Mike Heidke, a 28-second winner, led the Neenah High School junior varsity cross country team to first place in Thursday's Oshkosh North Invitational.

Heidke, who won the event in 17:48, was followed to the finish line by teammates Mark Kerins (18:16) and Jamie Remme (18:18).

Matt Berg was sixth and Eric Smiltneek 13th in contributing to the Rockets' 25-point total.

Wausau West finished in second place with 69 points; Appleton East took third with 106; and Neenah's No. 2 unit came in fourth with 116.

Chad Christian, in 19th place, led Menasha, which totaled 267 points.
