# Patriots execute marching orders

■ **Led by a 1-2-3 finish, the Appleton East boys' cross country team rolls to the Spartan Invitational championship**

**OSHKOSH** — For the Appleton East boys' cross country team, winning is as easy as one-two-three.

With Aaron Sass, Dugan Webster and Abe Mendoza taking the top three spots at the Oshkosh North Spartan Invitational Thursday, the Patriots ran away with first place with 48 points.

"I don't know what to tell you," said East coach Joe Perez. "Having those top three guys makes it tough for people to beat us."

Neenah came in second with 62 points, led by Don Alexandroni and

Ryan Freund, who placed seventh and eighth, respectively.

"We didn't do as well at the top as I thought we would," said Rockets coach Tom Jensen. "I think our four-through-eight kids ran pretty well, but East is awfully tough at the top."

Little Chute took fourth, with Ross Vandenberg and Andy Meyer finishing in the top 10.

"We had a number of guys that ran very well and then we had a couple of guys that were well off the pace today," said Mustangs coach Dave Janssen.

Other area top-10 finishers were Menasha's Matt Toeppler (fifth) and Oshkosh West's Shawn Berwell (ninth).

In the girls' run, West took first and fourth place individually, but came in third behind Wausau West and first-place Neenah.

The Indians' Bridget Kessen won the event with teammate Erin AufderHeide finishing fourth, but the Rockets' top five runners finished

seventh, eighth, 11th, 12th and 13th for a score of 51.

"Our strong suit right now is that they run well as a group," said Neenah girls' coach Ron Fedenko. "The downside of that is our group sometimes is a little back farther than we'd like them to be."

West coach Russ Hoxtell saw lack of experience as the main barrier to beating the Rockets this year.

"I think we have the talent, and I think we have the mental toughness," he said. "But they get together in that pack and they don't let go, and that's where they beat us."

Also making the top 10 were East's Heather Lichtenberg, whose sixth-place finish helped the Patriots finish fifth, and New London's Kristy Madden, who came in 10th.
